Challenge

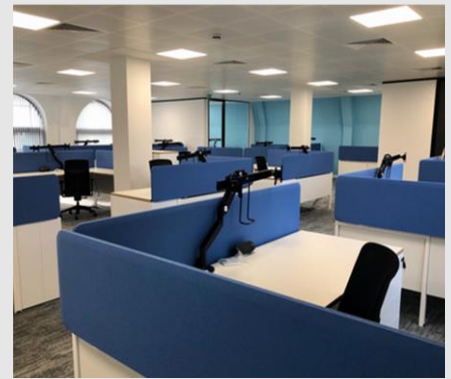
The Envista UK team had outgrown their facility. A new leader for this practice was relocating from New York and envisioned a larger, more modern office space in an urban area that would better suit hosting clients. They needed easy access to public transportation, whether rail lines or buses, along with parking accommodations in the metro area. Additionally, replicating design standards approved and in place for U.S. offices would be challenging.

Solution

Following the BW Property Group standard transaction process, Weston Bayes worked with the local brokerage team to identify three potential locations. The team toured three potential locations and a lease was signed in June 2020 for the Goldvale House. Weston also engaged Colliers International for build-out vendor recommendations. After working with the team to select the vendor, Valerie Nelke of BW Property Group attended vendor meetings to provide input on process, design and cost comparison details.

Results

The Goldvale House is a beautiful space that met all of the requirements and the team is extremely pleased and satisfied with their new location and space.
